Summer review:

Chesterfield: Ran their New Directions TR Camp and worked with partner Step N Up to have their Catch A Wave Summer Party with 70 participants.

Colonial Heights: Had a modified Rec and Roll from 9 am -12 pm that took place in parks. Ended summer with preschool prom event.

Ashland: pool had busiest summer that it ever had, including Play All Day VA. End of the season had first pup swim event with Guide Dogs for the Blind. Had 17 guide dogs in training attend. Used it for training and play.

King George: 50% of staff retiring coming up.

New Kent: Camp this summer, had a lot of inclusion needs, had camp 5 days a week k-5. There is a director/assistant director conference in April, look for more information soon. Opening for a rec specialist/programmer.

Spotsylvania: One week camp at Lake Anna. Let's kids get out in nature. Camp was for middle schoolers, and we can teach them how to fish, canoe, meet animal ambassadors, and get to meet a possum. If able to work with state parks, please do so. Most successful pool season only closed for one day due to

weather. Able to find plenty of lifeguards to work. Community clean ups and assisting VDOT with adopt a highway. Welcome Krystal who has been in her role for 3 months.

Goochland: Gutted space to provide camp space had 80 kids in a camp, did not have field trips. 3 half day camps and 4 full day camps in one building. Play All Day VA went well, had self-guide and instructor led programs as well as a scavenger hunt for prizes. Concession stand trailer being worked on. After school program for all three schools. One school had a waitlist of 7 kids. Using the cafeterias and gyms in 2 of the schools and using a rec center for one of the schools. The after-school programs run from 2:15 pm – 6 pm.

Hanover: Great summer programs this summer. Had staff led and instructor led summer camps. Served about 1,400 kids this summer. Camps went to 5 days a week. Capital projects going on now for replacing playgrounds, paving parking lots, and restrooms. Opening new rec center on Oct. 16th in Montpellier. The rec center is a shared space with the library. Big events happening in the parks. Cross country event taking place November 18th in Polegreen Park.

A lot of departments won VRPS awards this year in CSA. Congratulations to everyone.
